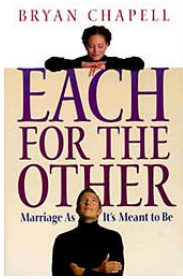
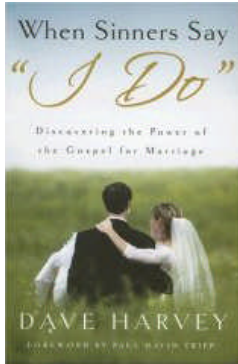

### **Each for the Other:** *Marriage as it's Meant to Be* By Bryan Chapell

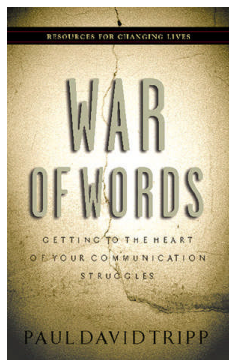
